2013 Policies and Guidelines

Day: Sundays May 19 thru Oct. 20 Hours: 10am-2pm **Set up time:** 8:30am- 10:00am* earlier the better!!! May start selling as soon as set up.

Please call Patty Bailey 608-774-9676 to confirm an earlier set up arrival.

Location: Chapel Specialty Grounds 819 E. High St. Grassy areas in front of Patty's Plants and Grassy area on corner of 26 and McEwan Ln. Overflow Small Wonders back parking lot area.

Please be prepared for rain, wind, sun

Set up: Cars/trucks may park next to their space except in the area in front of Patty's Plants which will be designated for tents/tables only. Products may be unloaded from the vehicle there, then must move vehicle to the Small Wonders parking lot.

Bathrooms: Bathrooms are located in the Chapel Specialties Building/Patty's Plants, near the vendor area. There will be someone from Patty's Plants on hand that day for booth coverage when bathroom trips are needed.

Cost: Daily fee \$10.00 per space (artist/farmer) or \$75.00 for 23 weeks

Sites available: There are at least 30 sites available with the *estimated* measurement 15' wide by 15' long. The space is of ample size with flexibility if your booth does not fit these exact dimensions. Vendor will furnish tables, tents and chairs. There are an additional 10-20 spaces with varied dimensions. As this is still new for us, we ask for your patience during our second year assembling the best set up for all involved.

Farmers Market Product Goals: Our goal is to create a welcoming environment with activities that will draw new customers. Our commitment is to the small farmer/producer and local artisan. Patty's Plants special dates "Spring Open House" May 19th and August "Fiesta Organica" August 18th are dedicated to providing opportunities for our greater community to SHOP LOCAL for all of their gardening needs.

Approved Items to be sold: Produce (fruits and vegetables), edible grains, nuts and berries, flowers (cut, dried), honey, maple syrup, canned goods (**properly labeled and processed in accordance with state standards**), homemade bakery, processed frozen poultry and meats, eggs, other ag related products, jewelry, painting, sculpture, woodcraft, quilting, handmade books, textiles, ceramics and other arts & crafts. Market administrator must approve all other products. **All prices must be clearly marked in public's view.**

Prohibited Items: Live animals (unless specially invited), rummage articles, products that are processed and sold under a brand name other than the vendor's own.

Application: Vendors must complete and submit an application form and are subject to review at any time.

Clean Up: All refuse **MUST** be cleaned up and taken away by vendor.

Insurance: Sellers are responsible for their own personal liability and product liability insurance.

Legal Requirements: Sellers are responsible for full compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws.

Violations: Violation of any of the policies and regulations may result in an individual being barred from further participation.
