

Patty's Plants

Dracaena Deremensis

Warnekii, Janet Craig, Lemon-lime



These Dracaenas are all easy low to medium light plants. They are used for interior businesses a lot since they are very low maintenance. The variegated leaf varieties work especially well to brighten a low light corner. Because of their large leaves you can see the collection of dust so be sure to dust them. Use a dust cloth you can wash out so you don't spread insects, should your plants have any. Dracaenas are pretty pest free. But that doesn't mean that they can't get something from another plant that might be infected. Let the soil dry slightly between watering. They are sensitive to their soil staying too wet. The leaf tips will be brown when they start to become overwatered. If they get brown leaf edges on the other hand this could mean they are either staying too dry or there's too much salt build up in the soil. They are also tolerant of low humidity which makes them a great indoor plant for dry homes or offices.
