Prayer Plant Maranta leuconeura

The Prayer plant is native of Brazil. Depending on the leaf color or the veining in the leaves the prayer plant has names like: “Rabbit Tracks”, “Herringbone”, “Red or Black Maranta’.

They close their leaves at night which gives them their name.

Prayer Plants can take low to medium light. A east or west window would be great.

Let the soil dry slightly between watering.

They do get flowers which you can keep pruned off if you don't want them.
